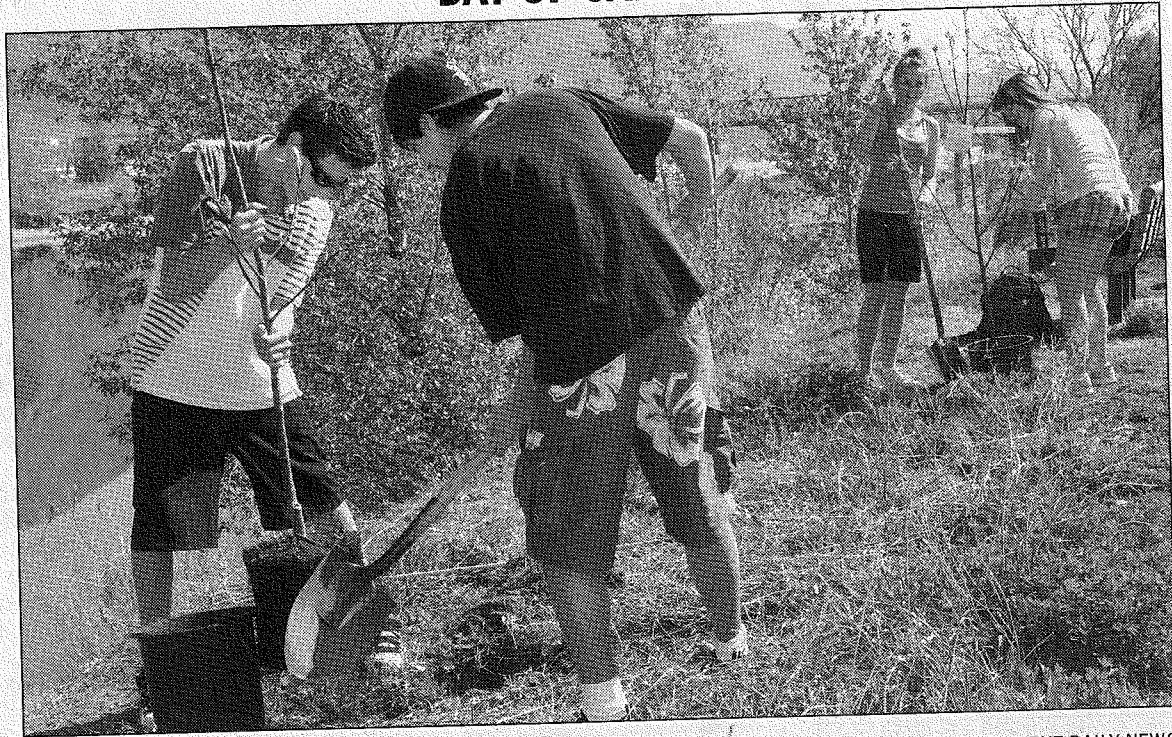


DAY OF CARING
