- Youth Mentorship - this initiative provides a volunteer mentorship for a School District #73 student to work once a week with United Way and get hands-on experience with community projects while learning about the programs and services local non-profit organizations have to offer.
- Success by 6 Business Engagement - Members from the business community are helping United Way to develop and implement opportunities for the business community to learn about why investing in children is good for business.
- Youth Initiative Grants - nearly \$10,000 was given out over the year to fund community projects created by youth to benefit their peers. United Way's Youth Advisory Council selected the grant recipients and provided support when necessary.

- Community Impact Councils - In Williams Lake, 100 Mile House and Logan Lake/Ashcroft groups of local United Way champions research funding priorities and allocate dollars raised in their communities to local initiatives and programs.
